Utah ICRC

- First proposed at Calgary ICRC
 - 1993 for 1997
 - 1997 (25th ICRC) went to Durban
- Proposed again at Rome ICRC
 - 1995 for 1999
 - Accepted for University of Utah
- Substantial funding from
 - NASA
 - NSF
 - DOE
- 3-part organization
 - National Advisory Committee
 - Frank McDonald, chair
 - Overall policy
 - National Org. Committee
 - TG chair as US C4 member
 - Organize sessions, select invited speakers
 - One member each for SH, HE and OG + chairs of NAC, LOC
 - Local Org. Committee
 - Gene Loh, chair
